



Banque Misr updated data privacy policy with GDPR

The European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a new applicable European regulation which aims at reinforcing the personal data protection within the European Union.

In accordance with our principles, our commitment is to provide a uniting security, transparency and ethic process. We affirm our will to optimally protect your personal data as well as the information legally obtained accessible from open data and additional service providers in the framework of our commercial relationship.

Therefore we only require from you the personal data we need to fulfill our obligations.

Your personal information are collected and retained from the beginning of the business relationship and updated until the end of the latter. Your personal information are used in order to provide banking and financial services in the process of the execution of your contracts concluded with us.

We keep your data as long as we cope with legal obligations in connection with the services we offer you.

Personal data are in the basics of banking and financial activity. Indeed, banks collect a big deal of them to identify their various clients, including those known as sensitive in particular nationality, professional situation or state of health.

These sensitive data benefit from a special protection under the new European regulation, which extends good practices in terms of confidentiality in order to highly limit data leakage.

Banque Misr Paris use the whole personal data in compliance with the provisions of the GDPR and update its own process for the implementation date of this regulation fixed on 25th May 2018.

The GDPR precisely regulates international transfers of personal data operated outside the European Union and the European Economic Area, provided that a sufficient and appropriate level of data protection is ensured.

Therefore, the Data Protection Officer (DPO) may only transfer personal data to a third country if appropriate guarantees are provided on the condition that you have access to opposable rights and effective remedies.

Third countries considered as guaranteeing a “sufficient” level of protection are recognized as such by the European Commission, which, after analysis of data protection by a State, may adopt a decision indicating that this State is likely to become a data recipient State.

In accordance with this regulation, you are entitled to request from the DPO **the access to your personal data**, to verify that your data is processed and to obtain a copy of this data, **their modification** in order to correct or modify inaccurate or incomplete data, **their deletion** (right to oblivion) in view to delete your data as soon as possible if the processing is illegal, a **right to limit their treatment**, a **right to data portability** in order either to retrieve part of your data in open and clear format or their transmission from an information system to another, a **right to object at any time**, for reasons regarding to its particular situation, to the processing of personal data or a **right not to be subject to an automated individual decision**.

Without any action from you, we will consider that your current choices are suitable for you.
